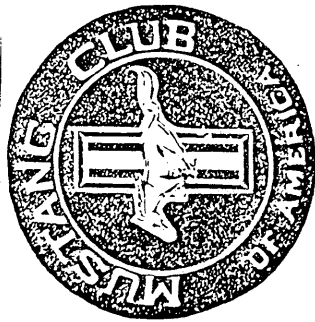

September 23, 1979

It was moved, seconded and passed that members bring a sketch of an emblem and moto for the I.D. of our group.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:28 P.M.

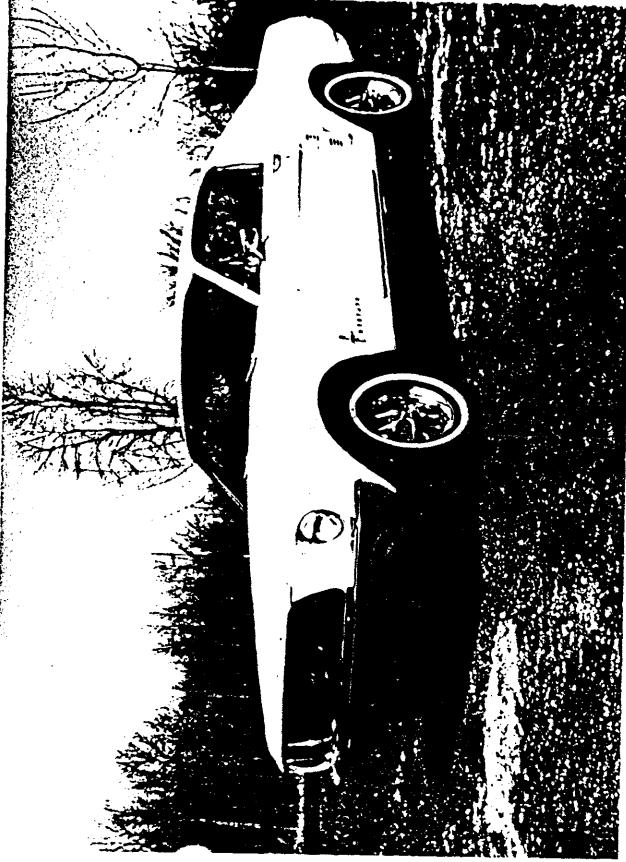
