Member Items of Interest

- Our club meets the last Monday of every month with the exception of February, May, and December. Meetings are generally held at the WaterStone Bank at 6560 S. 27th Street in Oak Creek, WI (just South of College Ave.) at 7:00 P.M. and we typically have about 50 or so members attending. We don't have attendance requirements, but we figure those interested, or with questions will attend, and they do.
- Our club participates in parades, road trips, cruise nights, rallies, picnics, etc.
- We hold our "All Ford Show and Swap Meet" each May on the Sunday preceding

Memorial Day. This has grown to be the largest All Ford show in the state.

- One of our favorite and most enjoyable activities has been the over the road trips. The sight of all those Mustangs together in a group on a highway venture is really impressive. Plus we usually stop along the way to have a great lunch or dinner and socializing together ...sometimes car related ...sometimes not. We've made many friends on these trips, along with promoting the Mustang image as we go.
- If you are having a problem with your Mustang, chances are that another member has had that same problem, so they can help you with the solution, or at least a place to go for the right solution. Being a member of the club, you don't have to endure a lone sick pony.
